- No Cost Today. A gift in your will or living trust costs you nothing today and does not affect your current cash flow.
- Control. Your assets remain in your control during your lifetime.
- Flexibility. You can modify your gift at any time if circumstances change.
- Tax Benefits. You may receive estate tax benefits depending on your specific situation.
- Impact. Your gift will generate future income to support Federation and/or the causes you care about.
- Values. Your gift makes a statement to your children and grandchildren about your Jewish values and commitment to Jewish life and continuity.
