ANTISEMITIC INCIDENT ACTION CHECK LIST



LEARN. EMPOWER. ADVOCATE with PURPOSE.

REPORT TO WHOMEVER YOU ARE COMFORTABLE:

- NO INCIDENT IS TOO SMALL TO JUSTIFY REPORTING IT TO THE AUTHORITIES!
- <u>Attorney General</u>
- House of Representatives report antisemitism
- <u>Hillel</u> (if it took place on a college campus)
- Anti Defamation League (ADL)
- <u>AMCHA</u> Initiative Submit Incident, Photo, or Video
 - Jewish Federation report an incident

Ask yourself if you feel threatened. If so, call emergency services.

- Call 911
- Police Department
- non-emergency line
- <u>Security Director</u> or <u>Deputy Security Director</u> at Jewish Federation of Northern New Jersey
- Jewish Community Relations
 Director

AND Remove yourself from the situation

If you do not know the person or do not feel comfortable intervening:

•Report the incident and call 911

If you feel safe, you can do either of the following (if you know the person):

- Address the incident immediately if you feel comfortable doing so
- Bring it up later, ask them questions and do not accuse as that can lead to escalation
- Consider doing it with an unbiased third party
