

# ANTISEMITIC INCIDENT ACTION CHECK LIST

REPORTING IT TO  
THE AUTHORITIES!**

## REPORT TO WHOMEVER YOU ARE COMFORTABLE:

- Attorney General
- House of Representatives - report antisemitism
- Hillel (if it took place on a college campus)
- Anti Defamation League (ADL)
- AMCHA Initiative Submit Incident, Photo, or Video
- Jewish Federation - report an incident

**1** Ask yourself if you feel threatened.  
If so, call emergency services.

- Call 911
- Police Department non-emergency line
- Security Director or Deputy Security Director at Jewish Federation of Northern New Jersey
- Jewish Community Relations Director

AND Remove yourself from the situation

**2** If you feel safe, you can do either of the following (if you know the person):

- Address the incident immediately if you feel comfortable doing so
- Bring it up later, ask them questions and do not accuse as that can lead to escalation
- Consider doing it with an unbiased third party



**3** If you do not know the person or do not feel comfortable intervening:

- Report the incident and call 911
